




LEVELS



<u>LEVEL 1</u> Just the letter names. Anyone can do this level — Perfect for an absolute beginner! (Sounds crazy, but some prefer to start on level 5)



LEVEL 2 Looks scary, but the same notes as level one, just written on the staff, the pros use.



LEVEL 3 Adds some left hand notes to make the song sound even better.



LEVEL 4 More complex left hand part, but sounds great even without the play-along track.



LEVEL 5 All the letter become numbers. Great for getting creative and switching keys! (HINT: some people find this level easier than level 1!)

PLAY-ALONG TRACK



Your play-along mp3 has different versions of the song at different places in the track:

0:00—Slowest and includes the melody being played just like you should play

2:00—Same track but faster

4:00—Even faster! This is the goal speed (tempo)

6:00—Goal tempo, but with no melody and no applause at the end - this is what you should use to perform for your family and friends

8:00—Goal tempo with no melody or applause, plus it is in the suggested key from the upper levels






















HAND POSITION


It is important to start learning to use all your fingers. Try this fingering to best cover the notes you need for level 2 on this song.








All notes are written on either LINES or SPACES. Use this treble clef chart to figure out what note you're supposed to play by figuring out which line or space the note is on. Need more help?










The bass clef graphs low notes.
